Museum Pass Policy

- Free museum passes are available to Union Public Library cardholders over 18 years old in good standing. A valid adult Union Twp. library card needs to be presented when the pass is checked out.
- Museum passes may be borrowed for three (3) days and may not be reserved or renewed. Only one (1) museum pass per household may be checked out at a time.
- Passes may be sent to the Vauxhall Branch Library upon your request. The museum pass will be held at the Vauxhall Branch Library until close of business the day the museum pass arrives at the Branch.
- The pass must be returned to the Union Public Library one hour before closing the day the pass is due. Passes may not be placed in any library book drop. Late fees are \$5.00 per day. A patron who loses a pass will be charged the replacement cost designated by the museum.
- Patrons should call the museum directly for updated information on hours of operation, parking and/or directions. Each museum reserves the right to determine the rules and regulations governing the use of their museum pass.
- You may pickup the pass at the Reference Desk at the Main Library or at the Vauxhall Branch Library. You have until 15 minutes before closing on the day the pass arrives at the Vauxhall Branch Library to check it out.
- You must return your museum pass where you received it: the Reference Desk at the Main Library or the Vauxhall Branch Library.
- The Library assumes no responsibility of any kind arising out of the use of museum passes or parking accommodations.


