



2023 Spearfish School District Drivers Ed

January 5-6: Early Registration for 11-12th grade.
 January 9-10: High School Grades 9-12th
 January 11-12: 8th to 12th Grade

1. Students must attend **30 hours** of classroom instruction and **6 hours** of driving instruction. (behind the wheel) These times are set by the state DMV as a minimum time requirement to pass Drivers Education. Due to this fact it is very important that the student is dedicated to the class schedule as there are no individual makeup sessions available. **Students are not allowed to miss classroom time or will be short of the 30 hour requirement.**
2. To be eligible for drivers education, students must turn 14 years of age by May 31st 2023
3. The class has a fee of **\$275.00.** (slot is only reserved upon payment) Checks payable to SHS.
 Option 1: Pay \$275 at time of registration at the High School Main Office.
 Option 2: Pay \$140 at the time of registration and second \$135 by the end of the course date.
Out of district students have a fee of \$300.00
4. An **80%** or higher is required in the class section in order to receive official certification.
5. After the student has passed the classroom portion with an 80% or higher, they will be issued an official certificate to obtain their learners permit at a State DMV office.
6. Driving times will be assigned by the instructor.
7. Not all insurance policies give a discount for Drivers Ed completion. Contact your insurance agent for details.
