Must apply to UNO, obtain NUID and password. Access the online <b>Walter Scott, Jr. Scholarship Application</b>. To prepare, gather and create the following required application materials before starting the form: Resume, Unofficial or official high school and college transcripts, ACT Scores, Portrait or headshot, Link to a 1-minute video. <i>In your video, you should introduce yourself to your future classmates, tell us about your past experiences, and touch on why the Scott Scholars program is the best place for you to pursue your degree. Videos should adhere to the following guidelines: (1) No more than 1 minute (60 seconds) in length; (2) Single take (no editing); (3) You should speak directly to the camera; and (4) Do not include background music or subtitles.</i> You will also be asked to answer five essay questions. Be sure to give yourself enough time to construct thoughtful responses.
