To provide students with an opportunity to explore the arts beyond the classroom curriculum. One of our main goals is to learn about art and how it influences, and is influenced by, the world around us.




Mission: STEM Club is designed engage students in challenges across areas of

2-3 Meetings per month, after school until the late bus.


