



Southeast Delco School District Food Service 2016 - 2017



The Southeast Delco School District will be implementing a new option available to schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs. This option is called the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP). Under CEP, all children attending school in the Southeast Delco School District will be able to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at no charge. Families will **NOT** need to complete any paperwork or applications to receive these meals.

CEP does not cover the cost of extra servings and a la carte (snack) items. However, these will be available for students to purchase. All student account records will continue to be maintained in a computerized point of sale system. Students will continue to pass through the serving line just as they have in the past, and they will use their food service student ID that is automatically given to every student. The system will record the meal, and allow Food Service Staff to see any allergies or dietary preferences.

If parents wish to put money on their students account for extra servings they may do so. The computer system will keep track of all funds deposited into a student's account. All purchases will be deducted from the balance until it is gone.
